OVERVIEW

BOND QUESTION INFORMATION

The March 3, 2026 ballot will include three bond questions. All Rio Rancho registered voters are eligible to vote on the bond questions.

ROAD BOND - \$12,435,000

If approved, the funding would be used for utility improvements and the reconstruction of Baltic Ave. (Lisbon Ave. to Southern Blvd.), Springer Dr. (Chayote Rd. to Santa Fe Hills Blvd.), Ridgecrest Dr. (High Resort Blvd. to NM 528), and Honduras Rd. (NM 528 to Riverside Dr.).

PUBLIC SAFETY BOND - \$4,365,000

If approved, the funding would be used to replace vehicles (e.g., fire engine, ambulance, and police cars) and replace the police headquarters roof.

QUALITY OF LIFE FACILITIES BOND - \$1,200,000

If approved, the funding would be used for library materials and equipment (e.g., books and digital services), outdoor improvements at Esther Bone Memorial Library, and upgrades to Sports Complex (e.g., skate park replacement) and Sugar Park (e.g., playground replacement).

The Delma M. Petruccio Art in Public Places Local Ordinance requires that one (1) percent of the proceeds of each General Obligation Bond issuance shall be dedicated for works of permanent public art that enhance the environment of the City.



PURPOSE

CITY OF RIO RANCHO'S ROAD, PUBLIC SAFETY, AND QUALITY OF LIFE FACILITY NEEDS

Rio Rancho's paved roadway system requires increased investment/funding (regular maintenance, reconstruction, etc.). This need exceeds the recurring resources currently available to municipal government.

Current revenues are not keeping pace with local government's needs for public safety vehicle replacements and facility improvements.

Additional resources are needed for parks and recreation and library services to address needs and maintain highly desirable quality of life amenities.



NO PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

If all three bond questions are approved by voters, there would be **no property tax rate increase.**

CITY OFFICE INFORMATION

The March 3, 2026 ballot will also include the following offices up for election:

- Mayor, 4-year term
- District 2 City Councilor, 4-year term
- District 3 City Councilor, 4-year term
- District 5 City Councilor, 4-year term
- Municipal Judge, 4-year term

All registered voters can vote for Mayor and Municipal Judge. Only registered voters from these City Council Districts will be able to vote for their respective City Council seat. To view a list of candidates, please visit www.rrnm.gov/rrvotes.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Absentee voting begins Tuesday, February 3, 2026. Voters may request an absentee ballot by submitting an application to the City Clerk's Office no later than Tuesday, February 17, 2026. Absentee ballot applications are available at www.rrnm.gov/rrvotes.

VOTER REGISTRATION

To participate in the Municipal Officer Election, an individual must be registered to vote no later than Tuesday, February 3, 2026, with the exception of those individuals who same day voter registration at an Early Voting or Election Day location.
